



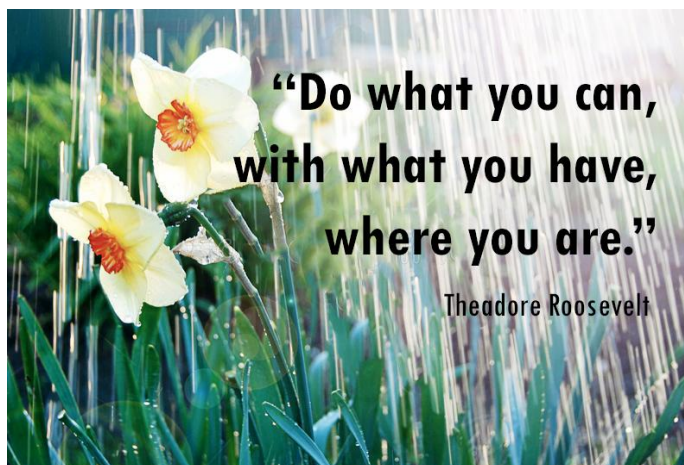

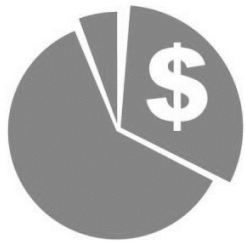

Whether a funder reads your narrative or your budget first, or simply the budget on its own, the same story should translate. It should be clear what your needs are both in words and in numbers. 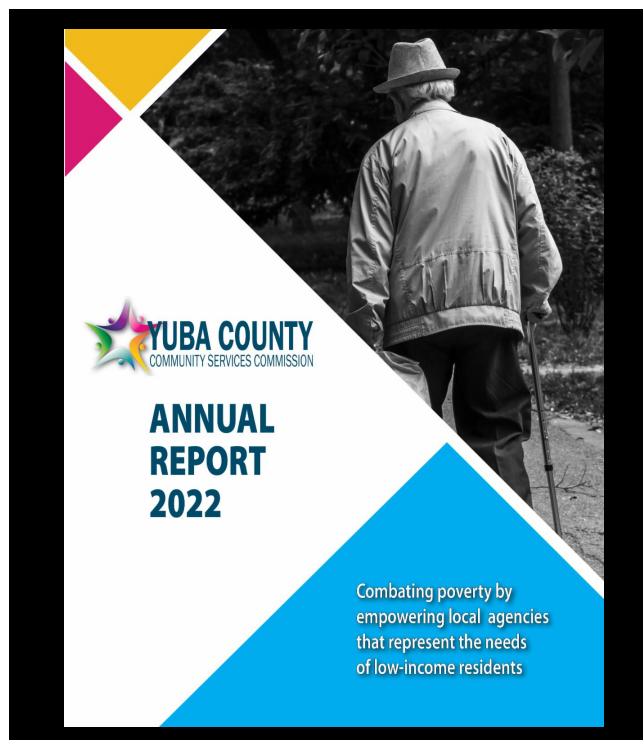
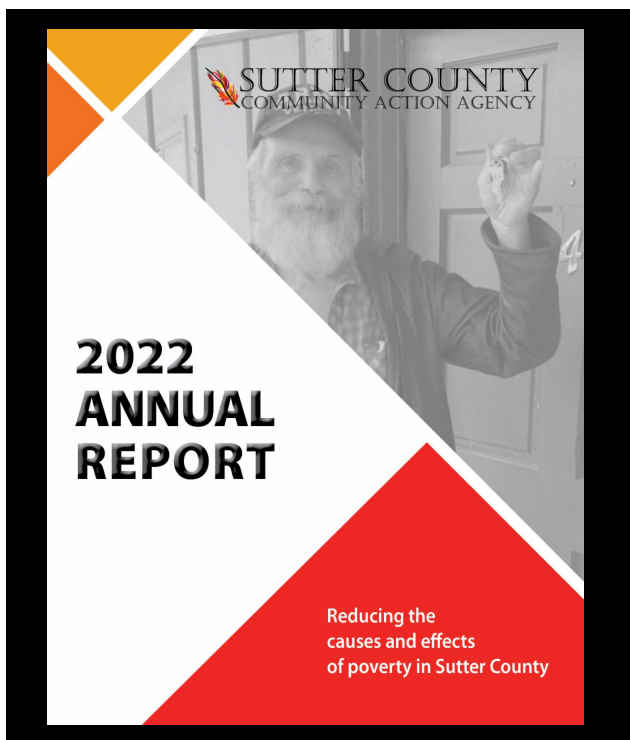
Seven Spring Fundraising Ideas

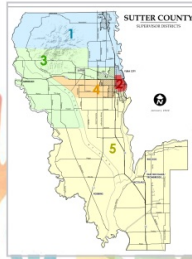

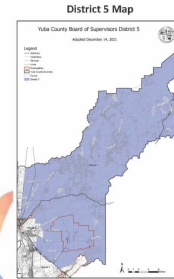
