

OTHER GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

The PIT Count is the primary source of nationwide data

on homelessness and identifies people living in unsheltered and sheltered settings on a given night. The PIT is essential in determining the scope of homelessness in the community. The community-wide effort gives residents and local businesses the opportunity to contribute and learn about people who are experiencing homelessness and gain an understanding of available resources to address homelessness. Volunteers will be needed the following dates:

The counting in Marysville and Yuba City will be on Monday, January 23rd.

The counting in Yuba County (outside of Marysville) will be on Wednesday, January 25th

The counting in Sutter County (outside of Yuba City) will be on Thursday, January 26th.

They would also like some "phone" volunteers to make cold calls to current clients and survey over the phone.


